St James's Church Legal Advice Centre was set up by Peter Thompson in April 1998, following his retirement from the Government Legal Service. It is located in St James's Church round the corner, which is the main Anglican Church for Muswell Hill. The Parish Church Council allows him to use part of the premises as a drop-in legal advice centre on three mornings a week, from 10 to 12. Services are offered to all, regardless of faith or ethnicity, without charge. Over 1000 clients have sought and received legal advice in confidence.
